"Our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio and films." Thus, we respectfully ask that no one photograph, videotape, or identify on audiotapes and in published or broadcast reports of our meetings, including those reports on new media technologies, such as the Internet, the name or identity of A.A. speakers and A.A. members.

As our Twelfth Tradition states “Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all our Traditions, ever reminding us to place principles before personalities.” (AAWS F-20)

If you think you have a problem with alcohol, you are welcome to attend this meeting. We ask that when discussing our problems, we confine ourselves to those problems as they relate to alcoholism.
